RINGS NECKLACES BRACELETS

METHOD 1:

MEASURE A RING YOU CURRENTLY OWN

Place your ring over the closest matching sized circle, make sure the inside of the ring fits around the outside of the circle. If you are between sizes, order up.



METHOD 2: MEASURE YOUR FINGER WITH A RULER

- Find a piece of non-stretchy string about 16cm long, or a strip of paper about 16cm long and 0.5cm wide.
- 2. Wrap it snugly around the base of your finger.
- Using a pen, mark the point on the string or paper where is overlaps, forming a complete circle.
- Compare the length of the string or paper to the lines on the paper below to determine your ring size. If yous is between sizes, order the larger size.

- When considering a wide band, move up a size from your measurement, for comfort's sake.
- Different countries have different ring-size systems. All sizes listed here are standard American sizes.
- The average woman's ring size is about 6. The average man's ring size is about 10.
- Your ring size will be about half a size larger on your primary hand (i.e the hand you write with).
